RULES

- When biking on roads, ride single file and to the side of the road. Obey all traffic rules.
- Stay off private property.
- Biking along/on/near M15 (Main St.) is not allowed. You may only cross M15 (MAIN) at Washington and at Cranberry Lake Road (can use alley to get to Washington)
- Must wear a buckled PFD at all times during the paddle. You will be disqualified for not doing this.
- Must wear a buckled helmet at all times during the bike. You will be disqualified for not doing this.
- Must punch passport at all CP's. It's your responsibility to punch at each CP and punch in the correct location. Must turn in an intact, laminated and legible passport at finish to be ranked.
- Notify race staff if you are leaving the race for any reason.
- Must be a ranked team to be eligible for prizes for top finishers. See required CP's listed below.
- To be entered in the bike raffle, you must complete the special event at Race Start/Finish.
- Leave no trace policy – what you take in, you should take out.

Start 8:00a.m. Depot Park near registration tent – Start on foot. These CP's must be done on foot. All 3 must be punched before you are allowed to go on canoe.

- CP1 – 7095 Hillside driveway
- CP2 – 3 Holcomb
- CP3 – Near creek

CP4 Manned – Transition to canoe. Check in with volunteer. Any Order

- CP5– Lake edge
- CP6 – Lake edge
- CP7 – Canal edge
- CP8 – North end of lake- find kayaker

CP9 Manned – Transition to bike. Check in with volunteer.

- CP10 – Near Fence
- CP11 – Bike Path south west of bridge

CP12 Manned – Bike In-Transition to foot. Check in with volunteer. (poison ivy)

- CP13 – Spur
- CP14 – Reentrant
- CP15 – Near Park Boundary
- CP16 – Creek

**CP17 Manned – Bike Out - Check out with volunteer –
CP18-22 in any order**

- CP18 – 705 Bald Eagle Lake Road driveway

CP19 Manned – Transition to foot – Check in with volunteer

- CP20– Reentrant
- CP21– Thick Vegetation
- CP22– South side of swamp

CP23 Manned – Bike Out - Check out with volunteer

Make sure you do the special event at start/finish to qualify for raffle drawing

It will involve carrying a M&M using a straw without dropping it into the designated cup. Can be completed at the start, before and after canoe and at the finish. Each racer needs to complete this to get a raffle ticket for all prizes.

Finish – Back at Depot Park at registration tent. The cut-off time is 2:00PM or 6 hours from the race start. If you finish after that time, you will be disqualified. At the finish, you must hand in your passport.

There will be a container at the finish for your raffle ticket to win a bicycle and to be entered in the general raffle. Make sure you split the ticket and place it in the container.
